WEAVING CLASSES and LOOM RENTALS

CLASSES: Weaving classes provide instruction for beginners and intermediate weavers.

Beginners will learn how to warp a loom, and weave tabby and twill fabric in the form of a sampler that can be used as placemats or a runner. Intermediate students will be instructed based on their level of knowledge. Floor and table looms are provided for use during class time and materials are available.

Classes Schedule:

The studio is open from 11 AM to 3 PM on Thursdays and Saturdays.

Cost: \$195 for 6 weeks plus (if more time is needed)

Included in the cost is 4 hours of instruction per week and the use of the loom.

Materials costs are additional and vary according to the project.

LOOM RENTALS: The studio has several large 4-harness looms and one 8-harness loom that can be rented by experienced weavers if they not in use by a student.

Cost: \$10 per day.

Renter can only be in the studio on Thursday and/or Saturday 11 AM to 3 PM during class time. Your project must be completed within 6 weeks. Some yarn is available for a fee.
